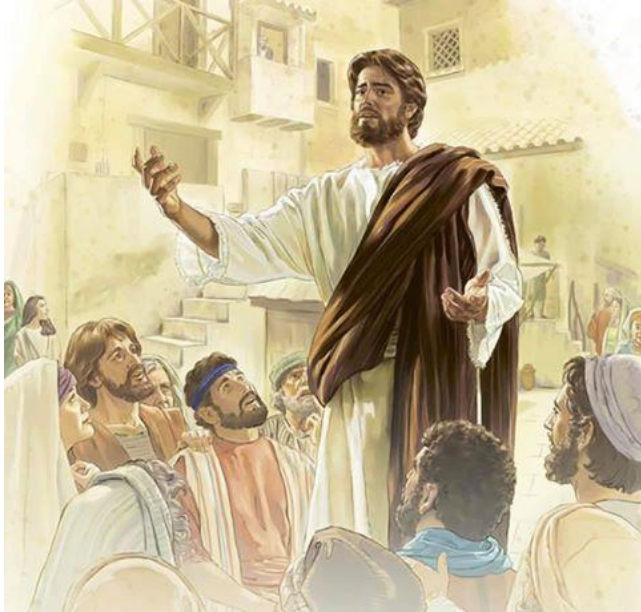

This Sunday's readings show us how God works through human weakness and the importance of faith. These themes help us understand how God empowers us and calls us to trust in Him. It calls us to have faith and recognize God's messengers in our lives.

When Jesus came back in his hometown he was rejected. People did not believe in him, even though they saw his wisdom and miracles. This shows that rejection is not a sign of failure. He did not let it stop him. Instead, he moved on and continued his mission. He even told his disciples to do the same if they faced rejection.
