

# **Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

21st July 2024



In the first reading from Jeremiah, God speaks against the leaders who mislead His people. God promises to step in and lead His people Himself, ensuring they are safe and well-guided.

God's care for us is constant. Even when human leaders fail, God's leadership is perfect. He will always guide us on the right path and protect us.

In the Gospel from Mark, we see Jesus and His apostles seeking rest. But the crowd follows them. Jesus, moved by compassion, teaches them because they are like sheep without a shepherd. He sees the needs of the people and responds with love.
